

Dear Instructors,

I'm writing regarding the latest information regarding our world championship (*combat nunchaku, free style NIA, WNA and FINCA*) in Vevey, Switzerland.

After discussions with Marc Chaland, Raphael Schmitz, Pascal Rocacher and the NIA comity, with the objective of avoiding ruling issues, encounters will be decided by a lottery system, on Friday, 4th of may 2012, at 8.30 pm in the championship building. Club or country representatives must be their, or at least have someone from their club/country.

Fight styles are the following: semi-contact, contact and free style; finals will take place on Sunday.

If we have the time, nunchaku-jitsu and snychro-kata will take place on Sunday.

For the fighters and their coach (for the fair play, to avoid issues and to do every category and to finish in time)

- Groin guard must be on before stepping on the fighting area, one helm and 2 nunchakus (one is kept by the coach)
- The coach must be there during the whole fight.
- The coach is not allowed to speak directly to the referee during the fight; the main referee can exclude them from the fighting area if needed.
- After the third call, absent fighters will be disqualified.
- **Fights are eliminatory.**
- For the free style: performers must provide their CD (not USB, Ipod, Iphone...) with their name and the track number before the competition.
- At 9 am, all the performers have to be on the tatamis for the introduction, fights start at 9.30am
- Regarding inscription, categories, rules, hotels as well as the address of the championship building, please check our website.
- All inscriptions must be done through the website. Before Saturday, the 28th of April.
- Payment will be done before the championship, from 8am to 9am, in Swiss Francs, Euros but try to have the exact amount.
- All the fighters must go through inscription and get their personal badge. The later will be brought to the referee table before every fight. It will be given back after the fight. The personal badge must be kept both days.
- Their will not be any STOP commands during the fights, only for the mid time break.
- The fights list will be given at the beginning of the competition but fighters will not be allowed at the referee table except when they give their badges before the fights.
- Only current fighters and their coaches will be allowed in the fighting area. The other fighters, public, parents or coaches must stay outside the fighting area.
- Entrée is free for public and family/friends coming along the fighters.
- Last word, we would like to remind fighters, coaches and public to respect fair play and do their best so everybody enjoys these two days.

I would also like to ask for lists of potential referees that you could "lend" us to have the fairest competition possible, please send them before the end of this year.

Cambodian food will be available during the whole championship (please bring Swiss Francs to pay)
